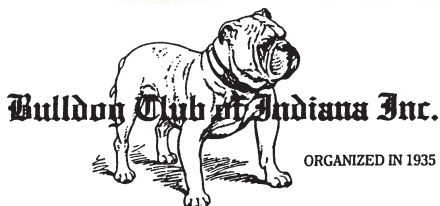

ENTRY FEES

NOTE: ENTRY FEES MUST BE RECEIVED FOR EACH ENTRY FOR EACH DAY! IF FEES ARE RECEIVED FOR ONLY ONE DAY, ONLY THE FIRST DAY WILL BE PROCESSED.

ENTRY FEE is \$25.00 for each dog, \$6.00 for Veteran Class (Saturday & Sunday ONLY), Sweepstakes (Saturday ONLY) is \$15.00 and **MUST ALSO BE** entered in a Regular Class. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes. The Recording Fees are to be collected on the first entry only. American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2. (There is no recording fee or event service fee for sweepstakes, futurities, brace/team, multi-dog classes, or special attractions.)

ENTRIES CLOSE at the Office of Roy Jones Dog Shows, Inc., WEDNESDAY NOON (EST), February 24, 2010, after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

MAKE CHECKS and Money Orders payable to Roy Jones Dog Shows, Inc. (Returned Check Charge \$25.00). All Checks Must Have Show(s) & Breed(s) entered written on the face. **THIRD PARTY CHECKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED!**

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of front & back will be accepted only if legible, and Official AKC size.

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

Rules Applying to Dog Shows • Effective January 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- **Entry fees will not be refunded** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or Roy Jones Dog Shows.
- **Error on entry forms:** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. There will be no refund for duplicate entries.
- **Returned checks and Post dated checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practical. Should such acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable amount of time, please notify Roy Jones Dog Shows.

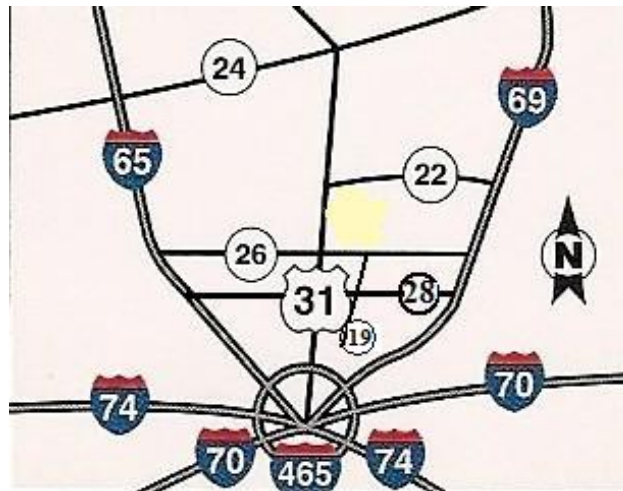

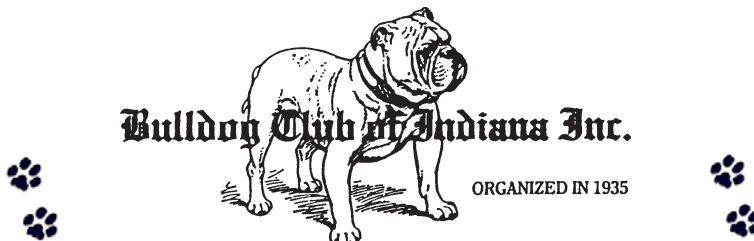
